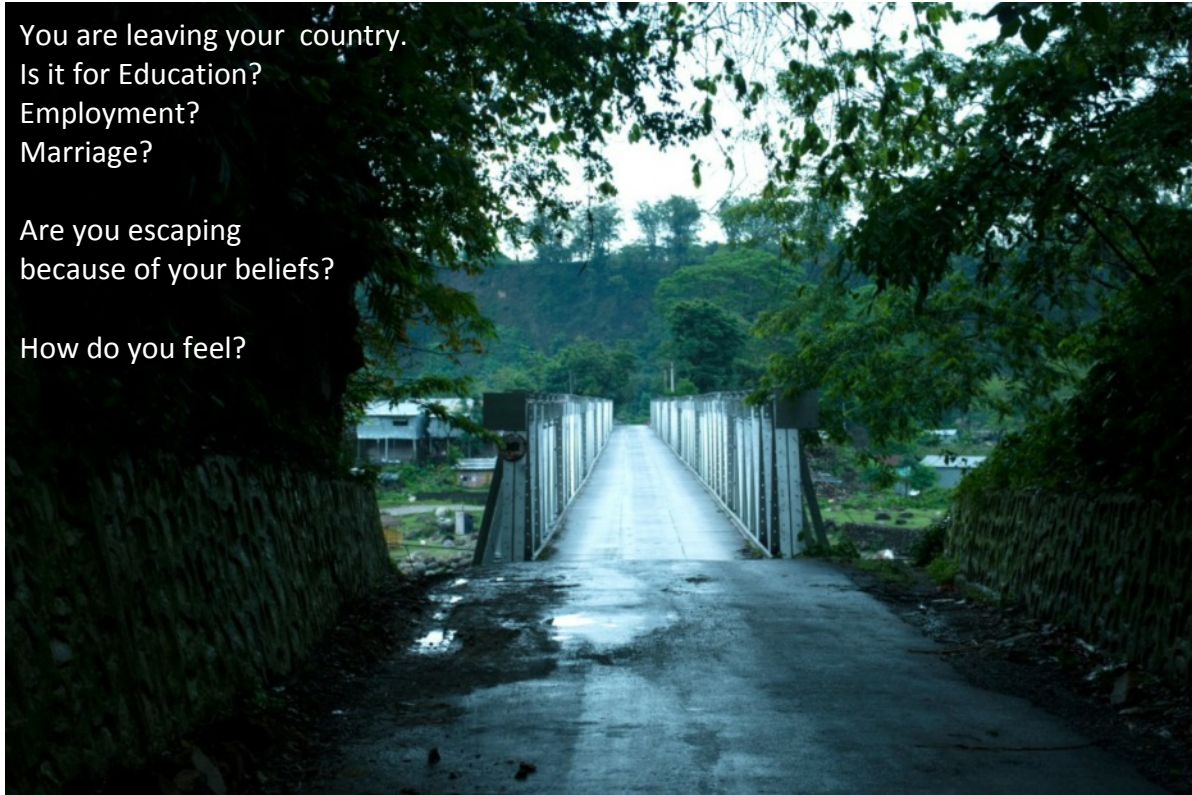
Life is like a bridge.
